

Case Study – Catalyst Communications Partners With Florida’s Highway Patrol



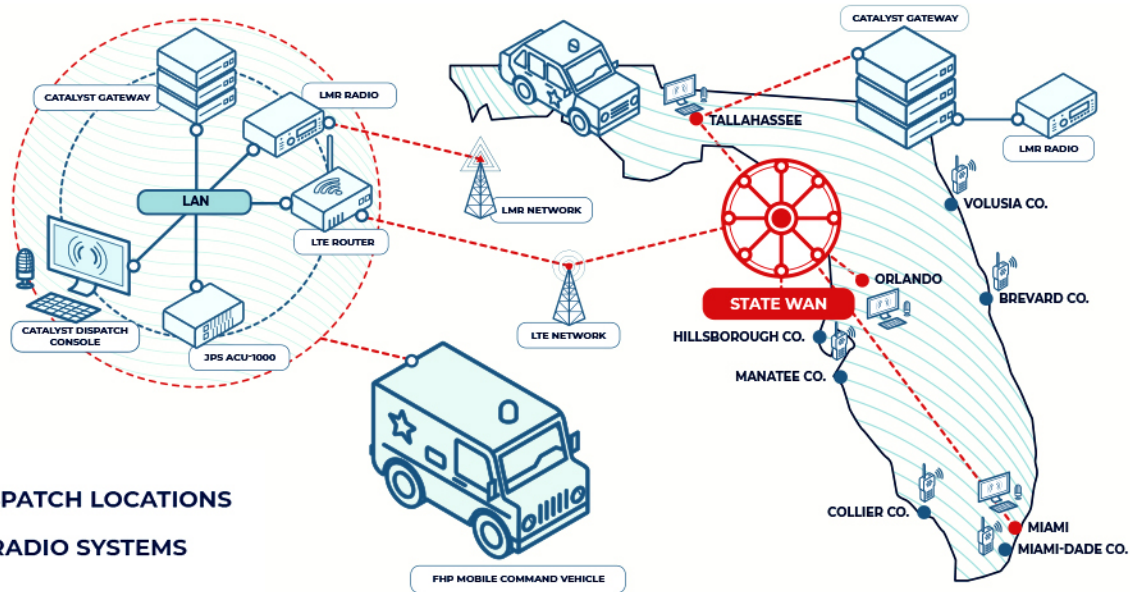
Background:

Florida’s Highway Patrol helps ensure the safety and welfare of over 21.5 million residents, plus millions of visitors every year. This entails everything from patrolling over 49.5 million miles and responding to over 150,000 crashes every year to responding to devastating natural disasters and large-scale incidents.

Client’s Critical Challenges:

- Incident response for the FHP can mean the need to communicate with upwards of 17 agencies and hundreds of talk groups across 6 or more disparate radio system technologies throughout the state.
- The FHP also needed a way to provide backup dispatch communications for multiple command centers across the state.
