
Background:

Florida's Highway Patrol helps ensure the safety and welfare of over 23 million residents, plus millions of visitors every year. This entails everything from patrolling over 43 million miles and responding to over 167,000 highway incidents every year to responding to devastating natural disasters and large-scale incidents.

- Incident response for the FHP can mean the need to communicate with upwards of 17 agencies and hundreds of talk groups across 6 or more disparate radio system technologies throughout the state
- The FHP also needed a way to provide backup dispatch communications for multiple command centers across the state
